CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

A. Conclusions

After analyzing all the data, the researcher concluded the results of the analysis as follows:

- There is no correlation between students' visual learning style and students' achievement in reading comprehension on students grade IX at SMP N 2
 Tojo.
- 2. There is no correlation between students' auditory learning style and students' achievement in reading comprehension on students grade IX at SMP N 2 Tojo.
- 3. There is no correlation between students' kinesthetic learning style and students' achievement in reading comprehension on students grade IX at SMP N 2 Tojo.
- There is no correlation between students' learning style and students' achievement in reading comprehension on students grade IX at SMP N 2 Tojo.
