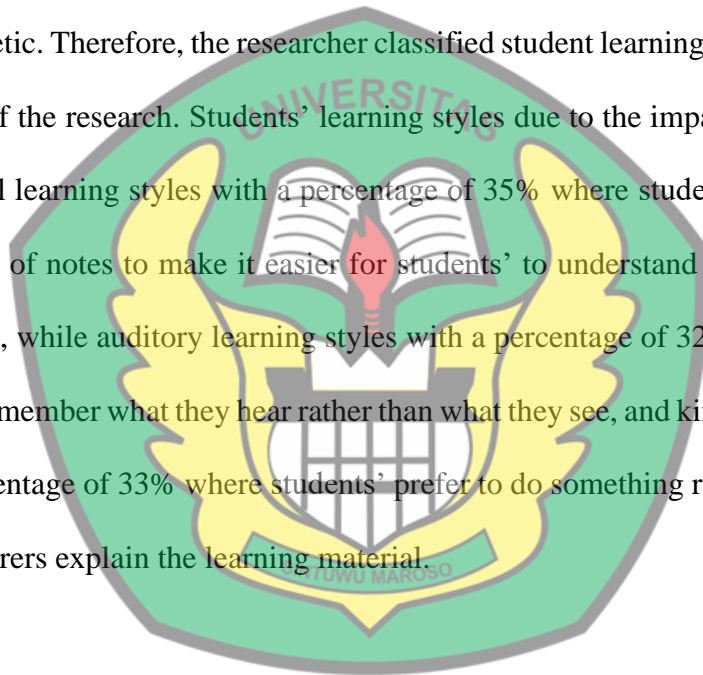


## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

#### A. Conclusions

Students' learning styles due to the impact of covid-19 at the Sintuwu Maroso University which appear in the learning process, namely Visual, Auditory, and Kinesthetic. Therefore, the researcher classified student learning styles according to the results of the research. Students' learning styles due to the impact of covid-19 tend to be visual learning styles with a percentage of 35% where students' prefer to read and take lots of notes to make it easier for students' to understand the material taught by lecturers, while auditory learning styles with a percentage of 32% where students' are easier remember what they hear rather than what they see, and kinesthetic learning style the percentage of 33% where students' prefer to do something rather than just listen to the lecturers explain the learning material.
