

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

After explaining the results of the data analysis, the researcher discusses the following conclusions and suggestions:

A. Conclusion

Based on the results of the analysis described in chapter VI to find out the difficulties of teachers in teaching English as a foreign language at SMP Negeri 6 Pamona Utara, the researcher draws the conclusions as follow:

The difficulty of teachers in teaching English as a foreign language comes from the understanding of the language where the teacher's low understanding of English which makes teachers teach using Bahasa Indonesia, and the difficulties in methods and approaches in learning where teachers find it difficult to implement learning methods in motivating students to learn which teachers also have difficulties in practical implementation which makes teachers difficult to build overall communication in the classroom to train student's courage in communicating, and the learning process requires media in learning to support the presentation of the material being taught. In this case, the teacher has difficulty in a socio-cultural environment where school facilities are low and difficult in access the internet due to the location of the school in an underdeveloped area.

B. Suggestion

After concluding and getting the final results of the research. Researcher has several suggestions that are expected to help in developing this research to get better research results.

1. For teachers: teachers must be more creative in helping students provide motivation to learn English, be creative in using variation methods in making the classroom less boring, and use simple media to support the learning process.
2. For students: students at SMP Negeri 6 Pamona Utara must learn more about English, because learning English will still be studied at the next school level.
3. For future researchers: a reference for future researchers who want to find out the difficulties of teachers in teaching English as English.
