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CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of the Research

Language has its own dialect based on their ethnic background. Indonesian has the local language in each of area. Especially Napunese one of the ethnicities in Indonesia has a special characteristic in their language system. Unlike the Indonesian language system that has sound /ə/, in Napunese language system there is no vowel sound /ə/.So it may influence pronouncing a foreign language, like English. As a non-native speaker of English has difficulties in pronouncing English words because their language system is different. Due to the different language systems between both of languages such a problem appeared.

Based on the experience of the researcher during observation in Napu, there are some Napunese students pronounce English words as well as the written form. For examples words *fruit* became /fruit/ in /fru:t/, *Saturday* is pronounced as /saturdal/. As in the absence of the change of Napunese vowel sounds system such as *ara* as /ara/, *imba* as /imba/. It causes the Napunese students experience mispronunciation of English sounds. Another example in the word "present" when someone pronounces this word with another vowel sound, it can give a different perception of native English speaker or the students when communicating in English. In this research, the researcher wants to describe interference in English.
